A. Canal C Project Update

- The District received two bids on December 21, 2023
- The bids came in very high:
 - Riobak \$1,848,396
 - Firethorn Inc. \$2,074, 041.61

A. Canal C Project Update

- Engineer has discussed options with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection Grant Manager
- A meeting was held with the low bidder, Riobak on January 16, 2024, to discuss ways to bring the cost down and South Indian River Water
 Control District performing a portion of the work
