
# South Indian River Water Control District

#### A. Drainage Fact Sheet & Video

## 4. Public Information Report (3C)



- C. 29th Annual Family Day March 18, 2023
  - Ads were placed in the Jupiter Farmer and Palm Beach Country Estates newsletter.

  - A custom invite was set up on the District computer to send out to local government and other officials the District works with.

## 4. Public Information Report (4A)



#### D. ADA Accessible Website

- Municode (who we were originally working with for hosting a new website) and CivicsPlus merged in late 2021.
- Prior to the merger, yearly costs for a new website were \$1750. After the merger, the estimate started at \$3300 in January of 2022, and at the end of the year, had gone up to \$4050 annually.
- Due to the rapid, multiple increases and since the District won't use many of their features, we recommended creating a new accessible WordPress website with hosting at \$1500 per year, with Accessibility Review Software (unlimited checks and corrections) from \$500 to \$1000 per year.

## 4. Public Information Report (4B)



#### D. ADA Accessible Website

- After discussion at the February meeting, Ms. DeNinno contacted Todd Wodraska at Special District Services to see if they offered website creation/hosting services.
- Their business is the creation, administration, and financial management of Special Districts – they use a stock Wordpress template hosted on GoDaddy. It is a very simple, mostly text template that is used for almost all the districts they manage.
- They could look into South Indian River Water Control District using their template and hosting, but we would still need to do the content, posting, etc. They do not use a service to check for ADA compliance.



#### D. ADA Accessible Website

- Wordpress has the largest market share of websites in the world.
- We would choose a hosting provider that offers services to ensure Wordpress templates and any plug-ins are updated.
- Since its inception in 2003, WordPress has undergone continual hardening so its core software can address and mitigate common security threats.



WordPress has 43% share of all websites and 64.3% share of websites using Content Management Systems.
