

A. Section 7 Update

- We are awaiting the final as-built information from Johnson-Davis on the four (4) additional culverts.
- A check for the final Request for Reimbursement was received from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection the week of May 1, 2023, in the amount of \$288,850.

B. Canal C Project Update

- The Florida Department of Environmental Protection is still determining if the project can qualify for No Permit Required, an exemption, or General Permit. We have reached out to the permit reviewer, David White, with no response.
- South Indian River Water Control District received the Grant Agreement for review and execution on May 2, 2023.

C. Water Quality Monitoring

- After last month's Board meeting, staff directed Pace to proceed with the new monitoring plan including using the in-state laboratory for Sucralose that is not certified.
- Staff has reached out to Albrey Arrington regarding what laboratory Loxahatchee River Environmental Control District is using and whether it is a certified lab for Sucralose.


