

7. Engineer's Report (A)



A. Discuss Updates on Fill Permits

- Staff met with Palm Beach County staff, Ken Todd and Jeff Gronborg, to discuss the SIRWCD comments on December 15.
- Palm Beach County has received comments from FEMA and has met with NPBCID, ITID and LWDD.
- Palm Beach County's Comp Plan Amendment to Article 18 is scheduled for April BOCC meeting (Article 18 – Flood Damage Prevention under the Unified Land Development Code under a new Chapter J for Single Family Lot Filling, Drainage, and Grading Requirement).
- The sample calculations for a typical lot are to be part of the Policy and Procedure Memorandum.
- Staff spoke with Palm Beach County staff on 1/11/21. They have committed to get with SIRWCD staff and report on what they have modified per the comments.
- At this time, Palm Beach County staff is not proposing to meet with landowner groups.

- Staff has moved forward with checking calculations and finalizing the design.
 - Staff is preparing 3 phases of the construction:
 - Riser construction (District purchases Risers, Contractor installs)
 - Easement clearing (Contractor)
