

A. Discuss Update on Fill Permits

- Received email from Palm Beach County on November 22, 2021
- Forwarded the email to the board on November 23, 2021
- Received some comments from board and forwarded them to Palm Beach County on December 2, 2021
- The Code Change is to Article 18 Flood Damage Prevention under the Unified Land Development Code under a new Chapter J for Single Family Lot Filling, Drainage, and Grading Requirement

Summary of Code Change

- Sets criteria for Single Family Lots less than 1.0 acre
 - Slope for swale is 0.3%
 - Berm around the perimeter
 - Stores runoff from a 3-year, 24-hour storm event in dry detention
 - No additional fill is allowed on this size lot besides the fill needed for the building and the septic tank
- Sets criteria for Single Family Lots greater than 1.0 acre
- Addresses Fill for Existing Lots



A. Discuss Update on Fill Permits (cont.)

Summary of Code Change - Draft Change

- Sets criteria for Single Family Lots less than 1.0 acre
 - Slope for swale is 0.3%
 - Berm around the perimeter
 - Stores runoff from a 3-year, 24-hour storm event in dry detention
 - No additional fill is allowed on this size lot besides the fill needed for the building and the septic tank
- Sets criteria for Single Family Lots greater than 1.0 acre
 - Slope for swale is 0.3%
 - Berm around the perimeter
 - Stores runoff from a 10-year, 24-hour storm event in dry detention
 - Area between building and septic shall remain natural grade
 - Additional Fill for Existing Lots shall meet above regulations



B. Discuss Section 7 Project

- Received email from Florida Department of Environmental Protection on June 23, 2021
- Submitted Agreement information August 31, 2021
 - Cost reimbursement grant \$353,650
 - Total Approximate Estimate = \$707,300
- Florida Department of Environmental Protection has a new project manager and staff attended a kick-off meeting held on November 3, 2021
- Contract expiration date is June 30, 2023, even though work plan states August 31, 2022 for Task Completion
- Staff has moved forward with preparing the construction documents needed to construct the outfalls.
 - Immediately staff has ordered three risers to be installed as part of the initial construction approved last year
 - Staff is preparing 3 phases of the construction
 - Riser construction (District purchases Risers, Contractor installs)
 - Easement clearing (Contractor)
 - Swale Grading and Pipe Upsizing (District)


